## What is it?

A Business Retention and Expansion Program (BREP) is a community-based program used to open lines of communication and build relationships with local business. The program promotes job growth by helping communities identify concerns and barriers in the survival and growth of local businesses.

The approach focuses on local businesses because studies show that up to 80% of new job growth come from exiting businesses, rather than new firms that have been attracted to the area. In addition, business attraction efforts are also more likely to be successful when existing businesses are happy with the local business climate.
